These are the items we discussed at the meeting.

Rachelle can you please:

1. Have a sign made that states the pool hours:

Effective the 3 <sup>rd</sup> week in July		
Mon - Fri	8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.	Unsupervised Adult Swim
Mon, Tues, Wed, Fri	12:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m.	Open Swim
Thurs	8:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m.	Adult Swim
Sat, Sun	10:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m.	Open Swim

\*Also send out E news with this information, and publish in July/Aug Shorelines - also note that Mon-Fri 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. is unsupervised, no one under 18 years of age allowed (unless they are in swim lessons or on swim team) but the time is for adults to swim, no kids in the pool area or on pool deck.

\*Aquaticare needs to provide a Hut Person on Mon - Fri 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. to scan in residents.

\*Aquaticare needs to provide lifeguards 8:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m for Adult swim ( this one is supervised)

2. Items we would like the maintenance staff to take care of:

\*Fix shower

\*Fix water fountain

\*Wax Slide and mushroom ( not sure if this is staff or Aquaticare?)

\*try and find bagger for push lawn mower when mowing grass around pool - until they can get a bagger, please make sure they are blowing the grass away from the pool.

3. Items we would like Aquaticare to address and take care of, if you could please let them know:
- Concessions need to be stocked better, residents complaining the concession stand is out of nacho chips, or hot dog buns. We had the concession stand make a list of what they were out of on June 16, and they were out of:  
Air heads  
twix  
ring pops  
ice cream sandwiches  
drumsticks  
plates
  - make sure lounge chairs are laid back when they close the pool
  - enforce "no chairs" policy in front of the picnic area
  - there has been "inappropriate behavior of teenagers making out on the pool deck and on picnic tables" Managers have the authority and need to inform the offenders that this is a family pool and their behavior is inappropriate. If the offenders do not cease their behavior the Manager can remove them from the pool, and can call the water patrol or police for assistance.
  - Pool maintenance: vacuum on a regular basis, verify water level is accurate, check and clean screens periodically during the day.

Other items:

- Dave MacQueen is going to get a bid on caulking around the pool. This needs to be done in September after the pool is closed, before the water is drained. Dave is to get Rachelle the bid so we can let the Board know how much money we will need to have this done this season.

- More upright chairs are needed, but we will get those for next year.

Pool Committee will meet the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of each month February - October.
