- Update on Work Session it was noted that Work Session discussion included recent no wake considerations.
 - It was also noted that Work Session discussions are NOT staying on task. There is a concern amongst the Lake Committee members that decisions in the Executive Session will be made without Lake Committee input.
- Boating Safety Articles Must have safety equipment for boats was provided
- Boat Approval Process / Training No updates
- Update On Dock Specifications Tabled till we have fact-based intel from qualified engineer
- South Boat Ramp Guidance Recommendation to put a cable across the south boat ramp to prevent public access
- Dock Failures Tabled till we have fact-based intel from qualified engineer
- Add a Second Rental Pontoon Motion to vote, 6 voted yes, 3 abstained, Motion passed. Lake committee formally recommends the addition of a Second Rental Pontoon.

New Business

- Board Question: Why front mounted lifts? Why do we not have a weight restriction?
 - Answers: The only option for the docks currently installed at Raintree are front mounted lifts. As for the weight restrictions, when the rules were originally written in 1985, it was recommended to NOT include a weight restriction. It has not been reconsidered further because it is extremely hard to enforce.
- New State Rule SB49 No recommendations at this time
