 - Week 4:

 - Wet bikes/Jet Skis, no jumping wakes

- Dock Inspections noted that dock replacement priority list was received and discussed by board

New Business:

- Lake Committee Member Election Discussion on right number of members as we have excellent candidates, and it is unfortunate to have to turn away qualified potential members.
 - New Members Elected: Brian Mitchell, John Mulvihill

- How to Measure Boats, and who should measure?
 - Noted that issue is mostly with wake and surf boats, where there is not a definitive point where the hull stops, and the platform begins
 - o Concerns that not everyone is interpreting the rules the same
 - Need to come to a collaborative consensus with the lake committee and the office (San, and Tim, want to meet with Josh from the office)
 - Goal to tighten these rules by the beginning of next season
- Float under the boat ramp courtesy dock No updates with Williams. Tim to follow up
- Courtesy Docks Noted that there is exposed metal that could damage boats
- Stakes 150 off dam at each end to mark area to tie up
 - Stakes are up as suggested
- Raintree boating age rule:
 - Missouri rule is 14, Raintree is 15.
 - Tom motions to keep rule the same (age 15), Dan seconds, 8 for keeping the operating age at 15, 1 abstain, 1 opposed. Motion passed.

Round Table:

Tom: Inconsistent enforcement of the boat sticker rules. Some people have just been warned, some people have been escorted off the lake.

Rich: A lot of non-resident usage is still happening.

Jess: Champagne point buoy is missing and needs to be replaced
