

LIFT GUIDELINES

Boat Lift Guidelines: Front-mounted, two round, or two rectangular, black or galvanized tanks. *Board approved August 11, 2009.* In the event any lift is deemed damaged or inoperable a notice to repair and comply will be sent to the lease holder/lessee. They will have 30 days from Notification Letter Date to comply or have a 4th level violation issued. The Appeal process may affect the time line. If not resolved and fine paid within the 30 day time limit, the lift will be subject to be impounded. If there has been not positive action to complete repairs or correct the issue RLPOA will remove and salvage the lift, repair dock and charge the Lessee the cost. *Dec. 2013*

PWC Lift Guidelines: PWC lifts must have one round, cylinder float (galvanized or black) or rectangular, black Poly Tank. *Board approved September 8, 2009.* In the event any lift is deemed damaged or inoperable a notice to repair and comply will be sent to the lease holder/lessee. They will have 30 days from Notification Letter Date to comply or have a 4th level violation issued. The Appeal process may affect the time line. If not resolved and fine paid within the 30 day time limit, the lift will be subject to be impounded. If there has been not positive action to complete repairs or correct the issue RLPOA will remove and salvage the lift, repair dock and charge the Lessee the cost. *Dec. 2013*

Use of used boat lifts coming from other lakes are not allowed. August 2015 & July 2016

Requirements for front mount lift movement from slip to slip:

- a) Reinforcement front plates and "X" bracing at any new slip location for a Front Mount Lift is required to be installed prior to the lift installation.
- b) Any Front Mount Lift movement will be completed by a licensed and insured contractor.
- c) The contractor will install the lift so that the lift is neutrally buoyant in the up position.
- d) The maximum acceptable lift length is 20 feet.
- e) All expenses for a lift relocation including the above requirements will be paid by the homeowner requesting the lift relocation. Approved 7-11-23



Small Efforts Make A Big Difference in Recreational Boating Safety:

The Water Patrol's overall Goal is to promote an enjoyable lake environment and ensure water safety. Raintree Lake residents have been key in making this goal a reality. Here are some reminders on how, as a boating community, we can ensure we have another safe boating season in 2023.

<u>Just Wear It.</u> Life jackets are the lifeblood of boating safety. Children 7 and under have to wear a personal floatation device while on board a boat at Raintree Lake. Getting an infant to wear them can be difficult, but it is a must.

<u>Operator inattention is the number one cause of boat accidents.</u> The captain of the boat should make sure all occupants are seated while the vessel is moving. At no time should a passenger be allowed to stand on the swim deck or bow while the boat is moving. This also includes launching from a slip or landing at a dock.

<u>Boaters while tubing are to stay 100 feet away from other boats or docks.</u> Make sure before you dock, pull in the tube and have all passengers on board safely. Also do not launch with a tube out from a dock. Wait till at least 50 feet away from docks to deploy your tube.

<u>Swimmers are not to swim more than 50 feet from shore.</u> If in a designated swim area, same applies, do not swim out past the swim buoys. This is a \$50 fine and a 30-day suspension from use of all amenities.

Thank you Raintree Lake residents for making Raintree Lake an enjoyable, safe boating experience for the whole community.






Lake Reminders During Storm Season
