- The January Shoreline contains our 2024 Board-approved Budget of \$18,250, which is the same amount that the Activities Committee requested.
- All of the 2024 Raintree Lake Committee-planned Events scheduled to-date are listed in the January Shoreline. [Food Trucks, or the Holiday Decorating Contest, are not included in that list.]
- Event Leads/Co-Leads:
 - See M. Legel's Notes/Questions at 2024 Schedule handout for any follow-up needs.
 - All Event dates were scheduled with the Office last September, and now include the recentlyset Food Truck Mondays. The only exception is for the make-up Outdoor Movie.
 - All Event times need to be decided by the Leads so we can plan for Event volunteers. Last year's Event times are noted there.
 - Budget dollars were divided evenly, except for Summerfest, and each Lead should review their Budget and we can modify as needed, sooner, rather than later.
- Spring Party (Crafts) may be added to the 03/24 Easter Egg Hunt, TBD. The Clubhouse will be used for Easter Bunny photo ops, restrooms use/access and the Spring Crafts TBD addition.
- We say goodbye to K. Springett, who was the Lead for the Adult Luau for many years. The outdoor Event is scheduled for August. The Clubhouse will serve as a back-up rain location. A possibility mentioned for the Committee-provided entrée is Hawaiian Bros Island Grill and/or Mo' Bettahs Hawaiian Style Food for the meat dish(es.) Attendees bring a dish-to-pass.
- On the subject of recruitment of additional Committee members and/or Community volunteers, M. Legel & T. Gill will look into a fun-themed item & Activities News blurb to be added to the Raintree Lake Welcome Baskets. [The Help Wanted ad has run for several months; it can also be added to the neighborhood Facebook page, as Events and/or Sign -Up Genius posts as Events are near.]

Follow-up Info:

- The Spring party w Crafts is being planned as an addition for the 03/24 Easter Egg Hunt.
- The Spring Event info will go into the March Shoreline, along with Food Trucks return & schedule (March (or later edition). Ditto for communication for the Events are posts to the neighborhood Facebook group, as well as the information sent through the Office weekly e-mails.
- 100 Fun & inexpensive Party blowers & the 2024 Activities list + some information will be added soon to the Welcome Baskets. The supply is anticipated to last ~ 1 year.
- A possible Boating/Other Outdoor Equipment Swap is being explored for early summer.
